Medical Quiz: Images

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A 62-year old hypertensive male admitted in ICU with altered level of consciousness and right sided weakness for 4 hours. There was no preceding headache, trauma

or convulsion. On examination, he had pulse-90bpm, BP-140/80 mm Hg, GCS-E3, M-4, V-5=12/15 with right hemiplegia. Immediate CT scan of brain and 1 day later MRI brain done are given.
