About 1000 participants from different countries took part the session. The inaugural session was followed by welcome reception. Among the other participants who presented papers in difference scientific sessions, some of the participants from Bangladesh also presented papers.

Two members of OGSB have been awarded with the Young Gynaecologist Award. Dr. T.H Johra Moon Moon & Dr. Ferdous Marjan. They presented their paper in the poster session. The Concluding session was equally good.

Postgraduate orientation course

A Postgraduate orientation course organized by OGSB was held from 7th October to 9th December 2011 every Friday in five centers in DMCH, ShSMC, HFRCMC, SSMC, BSMMU.

The resource persons were all the senior members of OGSB. Each Friday classes started from 8:00 am in the morning & continued upto 4:00pm. There was one focal person identified from each center. From 8:00 am there were Case presentations. After the lunch break, there was practical demonstration upto 4:00 pm. 235 candidates participate in the course. Candidates for the January 2012 session were given priority. During the class, Candidates presented the case & there was discussion on the specific case.
