## FIGO-SAFOG-SLCOG 2014 Conference, Colombo, Sri Lanka

FIGO-SAFOG-SLCOG Conference2014 was held in Colombo, Sri Lanka from October 30-2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2014. Eighty participants along with accompanying persons from Bangladesh attended the Congress under the leadership of Prof. Rowshan Ara Begum, President-OGSB. The Conference started on 30<sup>th</sup> November in the evening with Inaugural session, Hon'ble President of Sri Lanka was present as Chief guest. It was a very gorgeous event. About 600 participants from different countries took part. There were a large number of excellent and standard papers which were presented by different speakers from all over the world. There were a number of renowned speakers whose presentation enriched the sessions. The Banguet of the Conference was held on 1<sup>st</sup> October.

#### Symposium on Tobacco Control in Bangladesh

Symposium on Tobacco Control was arranged in OGSB Hospital & IRCH on 26<sup>th</sup> November 2014. The program was chaired by Prof. Rowshan Ara Begum. Dr. Shahida Zaidi Presented a paper on the "FIGO Initiative of reducing the burden of Unsafe Abortion; Prof. Ferdousi Begum (Vice President-OGSB) spoke about Menstrual Regulation with Medication (MRM); Prof. Farhana Dewan (Secretary General-OGSB) presented on the Long Acting & Reversible Contraceptive (LARC) and Dr. Yeasmin Jahan, DMP, Hospital Services, DGHS spoke on the role the GOB is playing in providing Post Abortion Care (PAC) services including Manual Vacuum Aspiration (MVA) & Post Abortion Family planning. About 150 obstetricians & Gynaecologist & Midwifery students attended the seminar.

The recommendation of this seminar were to

- Provide safe MRM services where ever possible
- Encourage the clients to use Long Acting Method of Contraception

## Opening of Reproductive Health (RH) & Family Planning (FP) Training Center on LARC/PM Services

Opening of the Reproductive Health and Family Planning Training Centre on LARC,PM was held on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2015 at OGSB hospital. The initiative is supported by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and USAID/Bangladesh through Engender health The program was chaired by Prof. Rowshan Ara Begum.

Dr. Abu JamilFaisel, Country Representative- Engender Health Bangladesh briefed about OGSB reproductive Health & Family Planning Training Centre. Chief Guest was National Prof. Shahla Khatun.Ms. Melissa Jones, Director of Population Health, Nutrition and Education, USAID Bangladesh, Director General Prof. Dr. Deen Md. Nurul Haque, Directorate General of Family Planning were Special Guest .About 80 participants interchanged their views in that program.

#### **Myanmar Conference-2015**

The 11<sup>th</sup> Myanmar Obstetrical and Gynaecological Conference of Myanmar Obstetrical & Gynaecological Society was held on 21<sup>st</sup> -22<sup>nd</sup> February 2015 at Yangon, Myanmar. Forty participants from Bangladesh attended the Congress. The inauguration of the congress was held on 21<sup>st</sup> February. There were separate SAFOG & AOFOG session & there was a

session for OGSB. During the session, the delegates from Bangladesh highlighted the importance of 21st February, the International language day. The conference was very organized and the Organizers were very cordial. There was good interaction among the Delegates during the sessions.

#### National Planning and Advocacy Workshop on Long Acting Reversible Family Planning Methods: OGSB

In order to reduce maternal mortality and morbidity and for the development, importance of Long Active Methods of Contraception and Pramanent methods(LARC/PM) of contraceptives are to be recognized. A National Planning and Advocacy Workshop on Long Acting Reversible Family Planning Methods was organized by Obstetrical and Gynaecological Society of Bangladesh (OGSB)& Social Marketing Company (SMC) March 15, 2015 (Sunday), Venue: OGSB Hospital. The session was chaired by Prof. T. A. Chowdhury & Prof. Rowshan Ara Begum. The special guests were Mr. Ashfaq Rahman & MD, SMC; Dr. Abu Jamil Faisel, CR, EngenderHealth; Brenda Doe, FP Advisor, USAID Dr. Md. Moinuddin Ahmed, LD, CCSDP, DGFP.

The paper presented were: "Background information & Overview of SMC and its LARC program': by Toslim Uddin Khan, General Manager, Programs, SMC; 'Long Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) in Bangladesh: Role of OB/GYN & Way Forward' by Prof. Ferhana Dewan, Secretary General OGSB and 'Current Status LARC Program of SMC' by Salah Uddin Ahmed, Head-Training & Service Delivery, SMC.

In Bangladesh the country wide LARC/PM FP program includes Injectables, Implants (1 & 2 rods), Cu IUCD, tubal ligation and Non Scalpel Vasectomy, which is delivered at all levels of health care delivery system free of cost through providers of DGFP. Recently these are also provided by the centers under DGHS in a limited way to ensure post partum and post abortion contraception.

But, inspite of this, there is still an unmet need for these family planning methods. Social Marketing Company is providing the long acting reversible methods with injectables, implants and IUCDS through private practitioners. In this meeting a new agenda has been chalked out where SMC will now work with OGSB and supply their commodities to the OGSB members all over the country through the branches of OGSB.

#### A Briefing session on PPH management through Tampostat

A Briefing session on PPH management through Tampostat was organized by Obstetrical and Gynaecological Society of Bangladesh (OGSB) & ICDDRB on March 7, 2015 at BIRDEM Auditorium-2, Shahbag, Dhaka. Prof. Farhana Dewan, Secretary, OGSB started & moderated the briefing session. The session was chaired by Prof. Rowshan Ara Begum and Prof. TA Chowdhury. The briefing session started with the presentation on overview of the study by Dr. Aminur Rahman and followed by Prof. Fatema Ashraf's presentation on clinical use of the Tampostat. After their presentation all experts were asked to share their opinion or quarries regarding Tampostat.

Following recommendations were made during the discussion session:

- Catheter will be used to evacuate the bladder in every case as per existing PPH management protocol.
- 2. Uterotonic drugs will be administered as per standard PPH management protocol.
- 3. During the study period it would be better to keep the device in situ for 24 hrs.
- 4. It would be easier to introduce the device if forceps are used to hold the cervical lips
