1. Comment This case of a ureteral fibroepithelial polyp is presented with only a macroscopic photograph. Histopathological and radiological imaging would be more appropriate for a case report. The discussion is also too brief, merely mentioning selected cases.

Response: We thank the reviewer for this important comment. We agree that additional images would strengthen the manuscript. In response we have added the histopathological as well as radiological imaging including the macroscopic images (Page 5 to page 8, Figure 1 to Figure 7).

2. Comment The PubMed keywords "Case Reports, Humans, Adult: 19+ years" yield more than 100 cases. Therefore, the authors should revise to clarify the unique aspects of their case and the complexity of the diagnostic evaluation.

Response: We thank the reviewer for the constructive comment. We naturally search a large number of heterogeneous case reports and no one is directly related to our case in terms of clinical features and diagnostic evaluation. We revised the manuscript and changes have been incorporated to Keyword, introduction and discussion section (Page 1 and Page 3).

3. Comment The references should be discussed in terms of their key points rather than "a study from Germany or so...".
