## Report on 1st National Scientific Conference Organized by CMOSHMC Teachers Forum

The 1st National Scientific Conference was a historical event held at CMOSH on 17th & 18th December 2015 was a grand success. Three Memorial Lectures were also included in this conference which was dedicated to Late Dr. A F M Yusuf, Late Eng. L K Siddique and Late Professor M Nurun Nabi.

- Along with the huge number of paper presentation, there were 14 excellent scientific Poster presentation and the best 3 were awarded prizes.
